Goldsboro - Reverend Amaziah Howell Jr., 94 of 1017 11th Street, passed peacefully on Wednesday night, September 28, 2016 at home surrounded by his family. The celebration of his life will be held on Saturday, October 8, 2016 at 11:00am at Barnes Chapel Missionary Baptist Church, 1108 Rosewood Road, Goldsboro, NC. He will be laid to rest at the Evergreen Memorial Cemetery, 3888 US Hwy 70, Princeton, NC with military honors.
