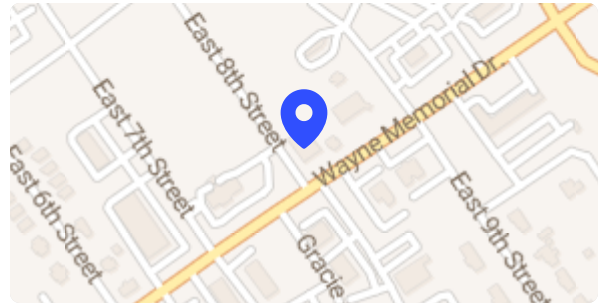

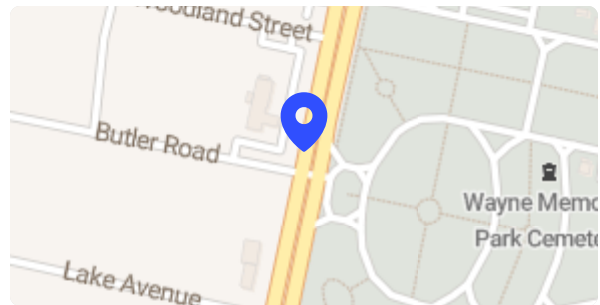

One day, I was violently beaten by this man...it was the first and has been the only time I have ever been hit by a man. The next day, out of the blue, the phone rings. It's Bobbie Ann. She says, "Jan, Ma wants to come and see you." I said, "Aunt Chris wants to come and see me?" You have to understand that Aunt Chris had never before been to my house. Plus, I lived in Fayetteville, and Aunt Chris lived in Goldsboro. I gave Bobbie Ann my address. My face was all distorted, and as I waited for their arrival, I thought, "What is Aunt Chris going to think when she sees my face?When I opened the door I said, "Aunt Chris, I'm sorry you have to see my face like this..." She said, "Lord have Mercy! The Holy Spirit TOLD me to bring my Oil! Bob Ann didn't we pass a store back there? Take me to get some Oil!"When they returned, Aunt Chris walked in Speaking in Tongues and Anointing Everything in her path, from one end of the house to the other, myself included. She anointed my house, and she anointed me...over and over, and all the while, she was Speaking in Tongues. When she was able to speak in her natural voice again, she looked at me and said, "Lord, honey, I didn't mean to put SO much oil on you." I said to her, "I thank you for every drop, Aunt Chris!" I was later told by the doctor, as the police took pictures, that either one of the blows could have killed me. Today, I have one tiny scar on my left eyebrow. It is there as a reminder of God's LOVE for me. He sent Aunt Chris to my rescue. My Mother and my Father had already Transitioned. For Aunt Chris to just show up like that...I know without a doubt, Aunt Chris was Led by the Spirit.Aunt Chris took care of the Spiritual part, like Mother would have; my Brother took care of the physical part, like Daddy would have. 😊...I'm also told that when I was a little baby, I had whooping cough and was very sick. My older sister told me that although she was a little girl, she remembers thinking, "The little baby is going to die." She said Mother and Aunt Chris were diligently Praying for me. She said she remembers me lifting "my little arms up like people do when they are Praising God". She said she can't remember what Mother did, but she remembers thinking Aunt Chris was going to break our floor! She was Dancing and Praising the Lord because she knew He had Heard their Prayers! Isn't that just BEAUTIFUL?!!So, you see, Aunt Chris has been Praying for me all of my life. I love her Dearly. All I've ever known of Aunt Chris is her Walking with the Lord. Now, she is in His Presence. My life has been greatly Blessed because of Aunt Chris, and I Thank God for her.I wonder what Aunt Chris, Mother and all of the Saints that have gone on are doing in God's Presence...Resting...Rejoicing...Praising...?We, who remain, all have a chance to know.
