Anthony Conrad Miller was born on February 14, 1954 to Burnice A. Sr. and Pernel Frederick Miller in Warsaw, NC. Anthony passed away peacefully on April 17, 2025, at home in Bronx, NY, he was 71 years old.

Anthony grew up in Warsaw, NC, graduating from James Kenan High School in 1974. Upon graduation, he joined the US Army and served his country proudly from 1974 until 1977. After his honorable discharge, he moved to New York City, where he met his life partner, Julia L. Hernandez, while they were both serving in the NY Army National Guard. 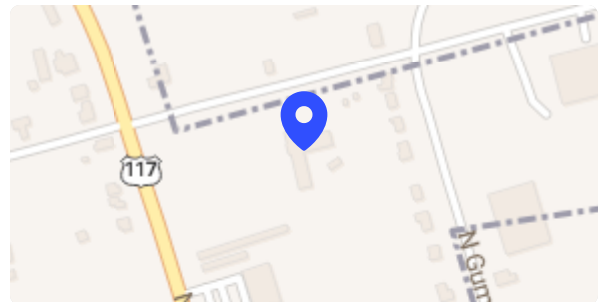

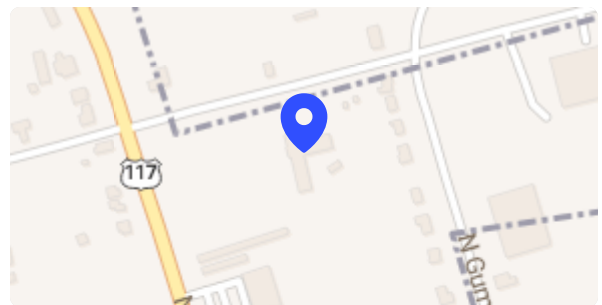

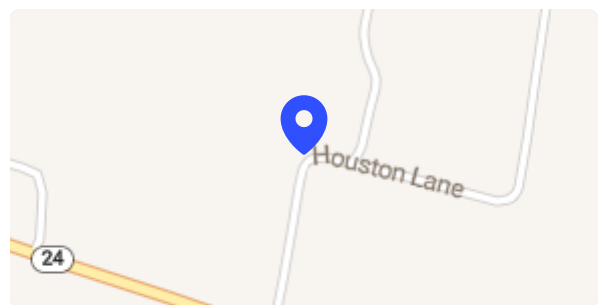
